

Privacy Policy

1. Introduction

The Friends of Tony Lopez for Wheatland City Council 2026 (“the Committee,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) respects your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains what information we collect through www.votetonylopez.com (the “Site”), how we use and share it, and the choices available to you.

2. Information We Collect

We may collect the following types of information:

- Contact information you provide, such as name, email address, mailing address, and phone number (e.g., when you sign up to volunteer, subscribe to updates, or contact us);
- Contribution information, such as donation amount, date, payment details (processed by our third-party payment processor), occupation, and employer, as required for campaign finance disclosure;
- Volunteer and event information, such as availability, precinct, or event RSVPs;
- Automatically collected information, such as IP address, browser type, device information, referring pages, and usage data collected through cookies and similar technologies.

3. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect to:

- Communicate with you about the campaign, events, and volunteer opportunities;
- Process and record political contributions and comply with campaign finance disclosure laws;
- Coordinate volunteer activities and outreach;
- Respond to inquiries submitted through the Site.

4. Campaign Finance Disclosure

California law requires certain information about contributors — including name, address, occupation, employer, and contribution amount and date — to be reported to the California Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) and, where applicable, local elections officials. This information becomes part of the public campaign finance record and is not treated as confidential once reported.

5. How We Share Your Information

We do not sell your personal information. We may share information with:

- Service providers who help operate the Site, process donations, or manage email/text communications, under obligations to protect your information;

- Government agencies, such as the FPPC or county elections officials, as required by campaign finance law;
- Legal authorities, if required to comply with a subpoena, court order, or other legal process;
- Successor campaign committees or officeholder committees associated with Tony Lopez, for the purpose of continued constituent communication, consistent with applicable law.

6. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

The Site may use cookies, pixels, or similar technologies (including third-party analytics and advertising tools) to understand Site usage and to support online outreach and fundraising efforts. You can control cookies through your browser settings; disabling cookies may affect some Site functionality.

7. Text and Email Communications

If you provide your phone number or email address, we may send you campaign updates, event invitations, or fundraising appeals. You may opt out of text messages by replying “STOP” and out of emails by clicking “unsubscribe” in any message, consistent with the CAN-SPAM Act and Telephone Consumer Protection Act (TCPA).

8. Data Security

We use reasonable administrative and technical safeguards designed to protect the information we collect. However, no method of transmission or storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

9. Children's Privacy

This Site is not directed to children under 13, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If we learn that we have inadvertently collected such information, we will delete it.

10. Your Choices and Rights

You may request to review, correct, or request deletion of the personal information you have provided to us, except where retention is required by campaign finance disclosure law. To make a request, contact us using the information below. If you are a California resident, you may have additional rights under the CCPA/CPRA depending on the nature and volume of data processed; contact us for more information.

11. Third-Party Links

The Site may link to third-party websites, including social media platforms and payment processors. This Privacy Policy does not apply to those third-party sites, and we encourage you to review their privacy policies separately.

12. Changes to This Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. Changes will be posted on this page with a revised effective date. Your continued use of the Site after changes are posted constitutes acceptance of the revised policy.
